As of now, we have full power in all buildings except in the Barrett and Incarnate Word buildings. Therefore, as in previous storms, if we do not regain power to those buildings, we will not have PK4 and Kindergarten students attend school until power is fully restored. We will continue to monitor the situation and relay information to you as it becomes available throughout this week and weekend.

If we need to move the location of before-care, we will let you know by Sunday where you can drop your children in the morning. At this point we do not foresee an interruption in our after-care program but will let you know if anything changes.
